

# CATEGORIES AND REPERTOIRE REQUIREMENTS

All music must be memorized.

Please be prepared to put composer dates on the repertoire the day of the auditions.

- **Pre-College I: Age 16-19.** 6 months to 4 years of study.
- **Pre-College II: Age 16 – 19.** More than 4 years of study.  
(A 19-year old student enrolled in high school must enter the Pre-College division)
  - \* Three songs, not to exceed 10 minutes
  - 1. A selection written before 1800
  - 2. A 19<sup>th</sup> century art song
  - 3. A 20<sup>th</sup> century art song (Folk song arrangement is acceptable)

Students are encouraged to use two or more languages.

One selection must be in English.

Post 1800 opera arias not recommended.

- **College I: Age 17-23.** 6 months to 4 years of study  
(Student enrolled in a college/university program, ages 17-23, must enter College I division. Students who are older, but in this same study time, should be in Recreational Adult I.)

- **College II: Age 20-25.** More than 4 years of study
  - \* Four songs, not to exceed 15 minutes
  - 1. A selection written before 1800
  - 2. An aria from an oratorio or opera or a 19<sup>th</sup> century song (original language)
  - 3. A 19<sup>th</sup> or 20<sup>th</sup> century art song
  - 4. A 20<sup>th</sup> century art song (in English)

Students are encouraged to use two or more languages

- **Recreational Adult I: Age 24 and over.** 4 years of study or less.
- **Recreational Adult II: Age 24-54.** More than 4 years of study
- **Recreational Adult III: Ages 55+.** Any number of years of study.
  - \* Three songs, not to exceed 12 minutes
  - 1. A selection written before 1800
  - 2. A 19<sup>th</sup> century art song
  - 3. A 20<sup>th</sup> century art song

Students are encouraged to use two or more languages

- **Career Path Adult I: Age 24 -54.** More than 4 years of study.
- **Career Path Adult II: Age 55+.** More than 4 years of study.
  - \* Four songs, not to exceed 15 minutes
  - 1. A selection written before 1800
  - 2. An aria from an oratorio or opera or a 19<sup>th</sup> century song (original language)
  - 3. A 19<sup>th</sup> or 20<sup>th</sup> century art song
  - 4. A 20<sup>th</sup> century art song (in English)

Students expected to use two or more languages
